To the Catholic Central Community,

We would like to thank you for your contribution to the "In the Heart of the City" basketball camps led by coach TJ Meerman and the Red Glasses Movement's Fall Charity Basketball Camp at Catholic Central High School. This year the Red Glasses Movement chose me and our family as the recipients of funds raised as we navigate my battle with Stage IV colon cancer. I was diagnosed in 2011 and while we have been able to maintain a normal life for most of the years of my battle, this past year has been more of a challenge.

This past year, I traveled to Miami, Florida to have a nanoknife procedure done in hopes of essentially electrocuting the cancerous cells in my liver. That spot has returned, in addition I have been hospitalized a number of times for infections in the liver and the cancer has grown in other spots in the liver as well. We recently spent a week in Cleveland being evaluated for a possible liver transplant only to find out after our last test that they will not be able to move forward with the transplant. Currently, we are waiting to hear from the medical experts what our next option might be.

The funds raised through the Catholic Central Basketball charity camp will go towards our family's medical needs, debts caused by our medical expenses, and any further travels or procedures that require more out of pocket expenses for us.

Please know how thankful we are for all the love, support, and prayers we truly believe that is what has kept us going for the past 7 years and will continue to lift up our spirits and willingness to continue this battle. We have a great team of people including us in prayer daily, and we ask that if you don't already that you lift us up in your daily prayers as well.
